### A LEGACY OF CARE

For more than a century, Norton Children's has cared for the children of the Commonwealth of Kentucky, Southern Indiana, and beyond. Along the way, we have achieved national, regional, and state recognition for innovations in care including pioneering treatment for scoliosis, being the second site in the country to complete a successful infant heart transplant, creating regional treatment programs for congenital heart disease, and establishing one of the largest plasmapheresis centers in the country. In 2018, Norton Children's Hospital received national recognition for its diabetes care. The hospital's Wendy Novak Diabetes Center was awarded a Certificate of Distinction for Inpatient Diabetes Care. Only three children's hospitals in the country received this designation.

As Norton Children's flagship hospital, Norton Children's Hospital is Kentucky's only full-service, free-standing pediatric tertiary care facility dedicated exclusively to caring for children. The 300-bed hospital, which serves as the primary teaching facility for the UofL School of Medicine Department of Pediatrics, is unwavering in its commitment to the community and region. For over 130 years, the dedicated staff at Norton Children's Hospital has worked to provide top-quality medical care for children, and the caliber of that care continues to receive national recognition.

### **EXPANSION AND ENHANCEMENT OF FACILITIES**

### St. Matthews Campus Expansion

Expand the number of pediatric beds at Norton Women's & Children's Hospital or elsewhere on the Norton Healthcare—St. Matthews campus, to include an Intensive Care Unit and Transitional Care Unit, with 40 additional medical/surgical beds and advanced pediatric imaging capabilities.

### **Outpatient Growth**

Build new, regional locations that will allow Norton Children's to meet the growing pediatric health needs in the region, and increase our capacity to provide unparalleled care, close to home for children and their families.

### **Autism Center**

Create a new, free-standing Autism Center to enhance Norton Children's ability to deliver comprehensive, family-centered diagnostic and care services to children with autism spectrum disorder. Providing a multidisciplinary, team-based approach to care under one roof bolsters our ability to effectively support the needs of children and their families.

### **Behavioral Health Center**

Create a new comprehensive outpatient center for child and adolescent behavioral health. The new center will enable Norton Children's to deliver comprehensive, world-class outpatient and crisis intervention services, coordinated under one roof. Expanded and re-imagined patient-centered spaces will allow greater capacity and flexibility to meet the increasingly complex needs of pediatric and adolescent behavioral health patients and their families in our region.

### NCREASED ACCESS TO AMBULATORY CARE

\$20 MILLION

Our communities' children deserve easy access to care when they are sick. Norton Children's will bring more care to communities at new locations and reach more patients through virtual care.

Expansion of our ambulatory services across Jefferson County and into rural parts of the state and Southern Indiana will enable greater access to regional pediatric subspecialists for some of the most vulnerable populations, ensuring the highest level of care to children in the region. As part of this effort, Norton Children's seeks to:

- Expand pediatric care in rural Kentucky and Indiana, where accessing care in-person is difficult, by expanding outreach efforts and increasing utilization of telemedicine.
- Increase care in underserved communities with new mobile clinics and outreach vehicles to provide additional services in cardiology, pulmonology,

- endocrinology, prevention and wellness, and early childhood development.
- Further develop the General Pediatrics program in the West End to increase access to primary care for some of the community's most vulnerable and underserved.
- Provide a Spanish-speaking outpatient practice in Louisville's culturally diverse South End region.
- Increase access to behavioral health care in the ambulatory setting by integrating Licensed Clinical Social Workers in every specialty and primary care practice.

Norton Children's has built, and continues to grow, nationally renowned clinical destinations such as Norton Children's Heart Institute, Norton Children's Cancer Institute, Norton Children's Neuroscience Institute, and the Wendy Novak Diabetes Center. Today, Norton Children's is planning a new Center for Care Transition to better support teens who require complex, longitudinal treatment and to prepare them for a smooth transition to adult care.



Investments in multi-disciplinary centers of excellence are critical to Norton Children's ability to meet the multi-faceted needs of our patients and their families. These commitments ensure our ability to provide high-quality, clinical care that is fully integrated and coordinated in one place, easing the burden on patients and families.

- Recruit fellowship trainees in pediatric subspecialties including cardiology and cardiac surgery, endocrinology, gastroenterology, gynecology, hematology/oncology, neurology and neurosurgery, urology, neonatal medicine, sports health, and genetics.


Every child deserves the best in health care. Norton Children's believes that highly personalized, quality care and treatment are powered by a commitment to continuous scientific inquiry and discovery.
